WHY TOO MANY PEOPLE ARE STRUGGLING TO SEE PROGRESS TOWARD THEIR PROPHETIC DESTINY

FOR I KNOW THE PLANS I HAVE FOR YOU, DECLARES THE LORD," PLANS TO PROSPER YOU AND NOT TO HARM YOU, PLANS TO GIVE YOU HOPE AND A FUTURE.

JEREMIAH 29:11 NIV

When I connect with people, businesses or ministries about how they are going when it comes to seeing progress toward their prophetic destiny, the same struggles seem to come up on a far too common basis. Most of the people I connect with know that the Father has a plan and a purpose for them, but few actually know what that could look like, or how to play their part in the fulfilment of that destiny.

This more often than not at some point will bring up feelings of disappointment, frustration, uncertainty and whole bunch of obstacles that seem to stop them getting the breakthrough that they are needing, leading them to a point of being overwhelmed, burned out, or just being overcome by their situations or circumstance. To be honest a lot of people including myself at some point or another go through something similar to this. Maybe you have or are currently experiencing this for yourself?

So is there a solution? Well I'm happy to say there is a solution and at The Prophetic Coach we are all about getting you equipped so that you can become more confident in the pursuit and fulfilment of your prophetic destiny. Let's look at some solutions by getting into some Simple Biblical Principles to Help You See Progress Toward Your Prophetic Destiny.

1 – CULTIVATE RELATIONSHIP



This may seem obvious to most, however this is the most crucial point in helping you play your part in discovering, knowing, and progressing towards the fulfilment of your prophetic destiny. I would go as far as saying if you don't make this point the priority then the rest of these points I make, may still help you, but are essentially meaningless, as they don't include the creator and the main source, who is God.

Cultivate Your Relationship With God

Cultivating your relationship with God helps you to know Him more and is the best source to finding out all you need to know about His purpose for creating you. The more you cultivate your relationship with Him the more you'll come to recognise His voice and the many ways He speaks. When you get to know Him and what He is like you will begin to find it much easier to connect with His heart, promises, plans and purposes for you. You will also begin to fall more and more in love with Him because that is exactly who He is - LOVE.

Cultivating your relationship with God is like growing a fruit tree; it takes time and effort to tend to it, yet when done well it produces much good fruit. There is no short cut to cultivating a good solid relationship with God. You need to spend time with Him otherwise you won't produce good fruit. It saddens me to see believers put God on the bottom of the priority pile and only pull Him out when life gets tough or when they need something. Cultivating a healthy and strong relationship with God requires time, intentionality and making it a priority in your life. John 15 talks about abiding and remaining in Jesus and that you need to do this to produce fruit for without Him you can do nothing. Jesus also talks about friendship with the disciples and that everything that has been made known to Him from the Father He makes known to them. In my opinion if we abide and remain in Him and develop a friendship with Jesus everything that is made known to Him can be made known to us. However this only comes through cultivating a relationship with Jesus and building a strong friendship that is consistent and lasts.

So how do we cultivate our relationship with God? Well like I have already mentioned we need to make our relationship with God a priority and make time to spend with Him. It's important to get some one on one quality time with God and also important to connect with God while tending to your daily activities. You can do this by reading scripture, prayer, worship, and having conversations with Him just to mention a few. The important part is that you make it a regular and consistent priority in your everyday lifestyle. By doing this you will build a strong and lasting relationship with Him and everything that He knows can be made available to you through that relationship and that includes everything you need to know about your prophetic destiny.

2 – GET PROPHETIC VISION



“ WHEN THERE IS NO CLEAR PROPHETIC VISION, PEOPLE QUICKLY WANDER ASTRAY. BUT WHEN YOU FOLLOW THE REVELATION OF THE WORD, HEAVEN'S BLISS FILLS YOUR SOUL. ”

- PROVERBS 29:18 TPT

Prophetic vision is so important when it comes to the pursuit of your prophetic destiny as it gives you direction to keep on track on the path to your prophetic destiny. Without it Proverbs talks about how people quickly wander astray. In other versions of this verse it says that the people perish. So it just goes to show how important it is to have prophetic vision in your life. I use the word prophetic vision over the word vision by itself because you need a God breathed vision not one that is self centred or comes from a worldly perspective. You want to align with the Father's vision for your life as it is His purposes that will prevail (check out Proverbs 19:21 NIV) and if you are partnering with that then it makes it easier to succeed in playing your part towards your prophetic destiny. Prophetic vision will align with the Father's purpose for you and if you align and partner with that you will prevail with Him.

So how do you get prophetic vision? Well there is more than one way to get prophetic vision and here are some ways to get you started:

- Prophetic words
- Revelation from scripture
- Revelation through connecting to the Holy Spirit
- Dreams/visions

Although there are more ways to get prophetic vision these are a good start. It is very important regardless of how you receive or get prophetic vision to be led by the Holy Spirit to know that it is Him at the source. It is also important to know that when receiving prophetic vision that it often can come in part and that prophetic vision can grow in more detail over time and will grow as you receive deeper revelation. There is a biblical principle which I think is important to apply here, and that is 'if you are faithful with little you will be given more' (check out Matthew 25:14-30). Although this passage isn't specifically talking about revelation I still find it a great and fruitful principle to apply to whatever the Father has given you. So I encourage you to be a good steward of whatever revelation you receive. As you are faithful with little, you will get more.

What to do with prophetic vision?

- Write the prophetic vision/revelation down and what it looks like in such a way that when you or others read it you all can run with it (check out Habakkuk 2:2). Even if you only have part of the vision write it down and be faithful with the part you have been given and over time you will tend to get more pieces to the puzzle.
- Do something to move toward it. In the parable of the talents the master was pleased with those who did something with what they were given and was annoyed at the one who did nothing. It's interesting that they were not told what to do but something was required.

3 – MAKE A PLAN



“COMMIT TO THE LORD WHATEVER YOU DO, AND HE WILL ESTABLISH YOUR PLANS.”
PROVERBS 16:3 NIV

When you receive a word from the Lord, whether it be through a prophetic word, a dream, scripture or some other means, it is important to do something with that word. If you read James 1:22 it says ‘But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves’. Jesus mentions that those who hear His sayings and do something with them are like a wise man, and those who do nothing are like a foolish man (check out Matthew 7:24-27). It’s interesting when it comes to some of the parables mentioned in scripture that there is an expectation of doing something with the words, talents or sayings or whatever is being talked about and that there is not much mention of what to do specifically. I find that when people don’t know what to do with the Father’s words there can be a way to common tendency to do nothing with what they have been given. I also hear some not so good advice being given such as “just put it on the shelf for later”. This can be ok depending on what you mean by placing it on the shelf. Wisdom is needed. From my experience, for a majority of people, it really looks exactly the same as burying your talent in the dirt. Just like the parable of the talents, this is the least recommended option.

So what should I do? I find that making up a plan that aligns with the word or prophetic vision that the Father has given to me, to the best of my ability and committing it to Him before doing it, has helped me and others I coach tremendously. It has helped in a few ways. It helps you align with His purpose and play your part in the process toward your prophetic destiny. It will help you act on the word that has been given to you in an intentional manner. It will help you measure progress toward your prophetic destiny. If you commit the plan/work to the Lord it helps you to stay teachable through the process and allows Him to establish your thoughts and plans. If done well it will help you to recognise the particular time or season you are in on your journey.

An easy way to start your plan is to look at the end picture first - that being the prophetic vision you have been given and have written down. The prophetic vision will give you the direction to travel. Then work out what you have currently in your hands that aligns with that prophetic vision. The key is to be faithful with what you have now and see it grow or transform into something that is going to help you move towards that prophetic vision. You can only use what’s in you hands and as you do more with what you have, more will be added to you. Look for what the Father is doing in a current moment because it can be common that He is teaching you something that will set you up for the next or upcoming seasons. Also it helps to break your prophetic vision down into smaller goals or steps. This helps with making your journey measurable. Jesus had a measurable plan and vision because He was able to recognise the times/seasons He was in, and was able to say to the Lord when that work had been completed (check out John 17:4).

4 – TAKE ACTION



“BUT BE DOERS OF THE WORD, AND NOT HEARERS ONLY, DECEIVING YOURSELVES.”
JAMES 1:22 NKJV

Once you have written a plan that aligns with the Fathers heart and have committed it to Him, it's now time to act.

I have found out in my journey that sometimes we don't always get the confirmation we need or the exact details we want from the Lord to step out and take action. One of the reasons for this happening in our walk with the Lord is because we require faith to please Him. It is impossible to please Him without faith (see Hebrews 11:6). Think about it for a moment if you are always needing confirmation or needing the exact details in every step you take, when are you actually utilising your faith? It's good to get confirmation at times however there will come times where your faith will be tested, and it may feel like you're stepping out on the water.

In my experience I have learned as I begin to take action and step out in faith the Lord establishes my thoughts and plans in more detail as I go. So if you have made a plan that aligns with Him, is committed to Him and you stay teachable by continuing to listen to Him, then He will be able to adjust and establish your plans and thoughts.

Some tips when taking action.

- When following the plan you have committed to the Lord, regularly review and adjust it as the Lord will establish your thoughts and plans in more detail as you go.
- Get around people who will champion you on your journey and keep you accountable in taking action. This will help you maintain momentum and see progress.
- Learn to overcome fear as it will try and hinder you taking action towards your prophetic destiny.
- You can't win a game you're not in. Taking action ensures you're in the game and continuing in the game helps you get good at the game.

5 – LEARN TO OVERCOME



“FOR EVERYONE BORN OF GOD OVERCOMES THE WORLD. THIS IS THE VICTORY THAT HAS OVERCOME THE WORLD, EVEN OUR FAITH.WHO IS IT THAT OVERCOMES THE WORLD? ONLY THE ONE WHO BELIEVES THAT JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD.”

1 JOHN 5:4-5 NIV

The last point I want to talk to you about is getting good at overcoming obstacles. As believers we are born to overcome. The thing is you aren't really an overcomer if you don't have anything to overcome. In our journey towards our prophetic destiny there will definitely be obstacles on our path that we need to overcome. I have heard some valuable wisdom from various people over the years, who say we need to bring solutions to our obstacles instead of things that are unhelpful. I agree that we need to bring solutions to our obstacles, and I suggest to you that this is all a part of becoming good at being an overcomer.

Some wise tips and questions to ask when approaching or hitting an obstacle?

- Is this obstacle mine to overcome? If so or only in part, what is my responsibility to overcoming this obstacle?
- What solutions can I bring to overcome this obstacle?
- What advice would the Father give to me to overcome this? And how can I apply that?
- What advice would I give to my friends if they were in the same situation?
- In what ways can I prepare myself to overcoming an obstacle before it happens?
- What lessons do I need to learn through this obstacle?
- How is this obstacle setting me up for the future?
- What is the best response to this obstacle?
- What is the Father doing or saying in the midst of this obstacle?
- How have you or someone you know overcome this same obstacle in the past?
- What support or counsel do I need to best overcome this obstacle?
- If I woke up tomorrow and the obstacle was gone how would I know it was gone? How would things be different? What would things look like? What would things feel like? What would others around me notice?
- What are 5 different ways of overcoming this obstacle? If you only have two options for overcoming something it can limit your creativity and resourcefulness in overcoming obstacles, giving you little choice in the matter.
- Imagine yourself on the other side of the obstacle as if you had just overcome it? What advice would you give your current self to navigate and overcome the obstacle?

These are just a few questions to help get you thinking and help you get unstuck when you approach or hit an obstacle on your journey toward your prophetic destiny. When you get to your prophetic destiny and are in the midst of fulfilling that destiny, remember there still can be obstacles to overcome. Joshua had to overcome many when he stepped into the promised land. Remember - with God you were born to overcome.
